Dear Ms. Zywiczynski:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department’s findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 04/13/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

<b>R 400.8134</b>	<b>Hand washing.</b>
	(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times: (b) After toileting or diapering.
Several preschool children were observed not washing their hands after toileting. Additionally, there were students that were using hand sanitizer after toileting. Hand sanitizer should not be used in lieu of soap and water, when available.	
<b>R 400.8176</b>	<b>Sleeping equipment.</b>

	(18) All occupied cribs, porta-cribs, cots, and mats must be placed in such a manner that there is a free and direct means of egress and must be spaced as follows: (b) Cots and mats must be at least 18 inches apart.
During rest time, the cots were observed to be closer than 18 inches apart.	

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 5/3/2023. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.


