II. Purpose of Addendum

On 01/18/2023, Licensee Designee Ms. Josie Draper requested the removal of school age programming, a change in age ranges served to children from 3 through 5 years, and a change in capacity from 50 to 20.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 02/05/2010, 11/29/2017, and on 01/18/2023.

Ellsworth Community Schools operates a GSRP preschool program in the elementary school building serving eligible children from 3 through 5 years of age.

The following rooms were previously measured, and are approved for child care use:

Preschool Room (first classroom on left): This room measures 34 ft. x 30 ft. minus a teacher desk area measuring 8 ft. x 5 ft. for a total of 980 square feet. Based on 35 square feet per child, this allows for the requested capacity of 20 preschool age children.

The following rooms are approved as additional child use space and were not used to determine the center's overall capacity.

Multi-use Area/Library: This space measures 40 ft. x 32 ft. minus a desk area measuring 8 ft. x 7 ft. for a total of 1224 square feet. Based on 35 square feet per child, this allows the center's licensed capacity of 20 preschool age children.

Cafeteria: This room measures 58 ft. x 38 ft. minus 12 ft. x 8 ft. for a total of 2108 square feet. Based on 35 square feet per child, this allows for the center's licensed capacity of 20 preschool age children.

The total space is sufficient for a center capacity of 20 preschool age children.

There is one handwashing sink in the classroom, and one toilet and one handwashing sink in the bathroom between the Kindergarten and Preschool rooms. There are an additional three toilets and three sinks in the girls bathroom,

and three toilets, two urinals, and three sinks in the boys bathroom located down the hallway from the preschool room.

The preschool classroom is equipped with a variety of developmentally appropriate toys and equipment.

The Superintendent signed the School Building Fire Safety Certification form on 04/21/2021. An Environmental Health Inspection with an "A" rating was completed on 04/22/2021. A lead hazard risk assessment was completed on 07/24/2019. No lead hazards were found.


Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 20 preschool children from 3 through 5 years of age.

The program is approved for meal service providing snacks and lunch to children.

V. Recommendation
