
R 400.8158(2)(b) Incident, accident, injury, illness, death, fire reporting.	In the fall of 2021, Ms. Groesser swatted Child A's bottom. Licensee designee Ms. Weaver did not report the incident to the department at that time.	Program administration will report to the department any incident involving an allegation of inappropriate contact between a staff member and child within 24 hours.	Immediately ongoing
R 400.8158(4) Incident, accident, injury, illness, death, fire reporting.	Licensee designee Ms. Weaver did not complete and submit a written report to the department within 72 hours of the occurrence of an allegation of inappropriate contact in the fall of 2021.	Program administration will report to the department any incident involving an allegation of inappropriate contact between a staff member and child within 72 hours of the verbal report.	Beginning 03/21/2022 and ongoing

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
