

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

For this renewal inspection, I observed child departure time, bodily care routines, transition to rest time, nap, and quiet activities. Staff members provided children with clear directions and used appropriate guidance techniques throughout the inspection period.


The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical Assistance was provided on the following:

- Examples of emergency care plans for children with chronic medical conditions.
- CCBC connections for staff working at multiple sites.
- A child may not begin attending the program unless immunizations or a waiver is on file dated on, or before the child's date of admission. Unofficial MICR records are acceptable as long as the child is up to date on their immunizations.
