This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 07/12/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violation found was:

R 400.8161 Emergency procedures.

(3) The plans required by subrule (1)(a) to (d) of this rule must be posted in a place visible to staff and parents.

On the day of the inspection the school-age program was using the gym. Emergency plans and an evacuation diagram were not posted in this room.

CONSULTATION:

According to the program director of the school-age program, parents are contacting her using her own person cell phone number. A different number, provided by the licensee, should be made known and available to parents to contact her regarding children enrolled in the program.

Due to the violation, you must send us a corrective action plan by 8/7/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with the rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for the violation.
- Specific time frames for the violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
