III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility The child care center is located in a stand alone building in Nashville, MI. The building was previously a doctor's office and has completed all required inspections to be licensed.

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.): The child care center consists of two rooms for child use as well as a large entry area for parents and children.

The infant room measures 19 ft. x 12 ft and 15 ft. x 12 ft for a total of 408 square feet. This supports a capacity of 8 children aged birth to 2.5 years old.

The toddler room measures 9 ft x 7 ft., 15 ft. x 15 ft. and 13 ft. x 11 ft. for a total of 431 square feet. This supports a capacity of 8 children aged birth to 2.5 years old.

The total square footage is sufficient for the requested capacity of 16 children.

Equipment: The child care center has an adequate amount of developmentally appropriate materials for the ages and capacity requested.

Number of sinks and toilets: The child care center has 2 toilets and 3 handwashing sinks for child use. This is sufficient for one sink and toilet per 15 children.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards: The outdoor play area is located in the side yard of the building. It is currently not fenced but the licensee understands that active supervision must be maintained and will look into finding cones or a way to make visual boundaries. There are also strollers and wagons to take children for walks around the parking area and outdoor toys such as bubbles, balls, and sidewalk chalk. There are no currently no play structures.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results: A lead hazard risk assessment was not required as the building was constructed after 1978.

Documentation of playground safety: A playground safety inspection was not required.

B. Program Description

Ages of children served: The child care center will serve children aged birth to 2.5 years.

Proposed days and hours of operation: The child care center will operate Monday through Friday 6:30am to 6:00pm.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both): The child care center will operate full time, and year round.

Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service: There are no other program components. Parents will provide all food, there is no transportation or swimming.

Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified: The approved Program Director is Brooke Allman. Ms. Allman was previously 9/18/2018 approved under rule 8113(9)(c) and (13).

Is there a central administrator that meets the administrative requirement? There is no central administrator required.
