II. Purpose of Addendum

Ms. Colberg rearranged her toddler area to accommodate eight toddlers instead of four toddlers. This decreases the preschool area to accommodate eight preschool children.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Description of Facility Ready Set Grow is located on Moll Street, across from Auburn Elementary School in Auburn. All areas have been approved for child use with the exception of the office area, kitchen, storage, and furnace rooms.

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):

Infant Room - The infant area for children 2-1/2 years and under is in a separate room from the rest of the center. The area consists of one larger room which is 19' X 18' with two adjoining smaller crib rooms, each 8' X 9'. The total square footage in the infant room is 486 square feet, which is adequate for the requested capacity of **8 infants**. The changing area is in the infant room and there is a handwashing sink and a food preparation sink for the infant child care staff to use.

The other room in the center is open and divided into four well defined spaces. Each of these spaces should have their own lead teacher with the exception of the school age area.

Toddlers - The area for children under 2-1/2 years measures 15' X 13' for a total of 195 square feet. This is adequate for the requested capacity of 8 toddlers. The toddler space is separated from the main area used by older children using moveable furniture.

Preschool - The area behind the toddler space is for preschool children. It measures 20' X 22' for a total of 440 square feet. This is sufficient space for 12 preschool children.

GSRP Preschool - The area designated for GSRP preschool measures 23' X 26' and 17' X 12' for a total of 802 square feet. This is sufficient space for 22 preschool age children and older.

School age/preschool space- This space measures 18' X 23' and 4' X 5' for a total of 434 square feet. This is sufficient for 12 preschool/school age children.

Equipment: The classrooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. There are adequate amounts of equipment to support the capacity requested.

Number of sinks and toilets: The center has a handwashing sink in the infant/toddler room. There are four handwashing sinks and four toilets in the two bathrooms for children. This is sufficient to serve the requested capacity.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards: The outdoor play area is located directly behind the center. It is fully enclosed with fencing.

Documentation of playground safety: The playground was inspected on 8/02/2021 and approved by a certified playground inspector. The playground equipment includes a composite playground structure, swing set, caterpillar, and log home. All the equipment has been approved for children ages 2- 12.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results: The building was built in 1979 and does not require a lead assessment. .

Program Description

Ages of children served: The center will serve children age birth through 12 years. Proposed days and hours of operation: The center will operate year-round Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both): The center does operate a full time Great Start to Readiness Program that is open to children that qualify. 4

Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service: The center will provide breakfast, morning snack, lunch, and an afternoon snack.

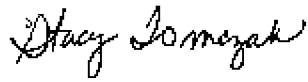
Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified: Ashley Stevens is the approved program director. She was approved under R400.8113 (9)(c) and (13).

Explanation of variance(s), if any: There are no variances.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approving the changed space for eight toddlers and the preschool space for 8 preschool children. The capacity will remain the same for 58 children.
