III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, child care staff members engaged in positive interactions with children during diapering, toileting, bottle feeding, indoor play, tummy time, rest time, snack, and outdoor play. Child care staff members were intentional in their conversations and actions with the children. All classrooms were well maintained and organized. Center records were readily available and organized.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

I provided licensee designee Danielle Poindexter with technical assistance for the following:

Rest time: quiet activities should be made available to children who do not sleep during rest time.

Toileting and diapering: consider a different routine to reduce the amount of “wait” time for children.

Snack/meal prep: consider prepping food ahead of time to reduce the amount of “wait” time for children and to ensure appropriate care and supervision during meals and snacks.

Medication: a doctor’s note is required for over-the-counter medication that does not provide dosage for age of the child.

Immunizations: ensure that MCIR or other documentation of immunization is printed out on or before the date of initial attendance and on file at the center.

Child information cards: unless otherwise indicated, all requested information must be provided. If the information is not known or does not apply, “unknown” or “none” is the required response. **Note**: a blank field, a line through a field or “N/A” are not acceptable responses.

Special dietary needs: alternative snack/meal components for children with special dietary needs should be planned ahead of time and properly documented.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of an original license to this child care center.
