On 08/08/2022 Licensee designee William Henry requested that room 130 be approved as child use space.

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 08/18/2011, 07/31/2019, 10/27/2020 and 09/08/2022.

On 09/08/2022 an inspection was completed. Room 130 and the boys' and girls' restrooms located in the same hallway were inspected and found to be safe and appropriate for child use.

Room 188 is no longer used by the child care center.

### A. Description of Facility

This preschool is located in Pickford Elementary School. The following rooms have been approved for child use with a total capacity of 20 children:

Room 130: 27.75 feet X 24.75 feet = 686.8 square feet (maximum capacity 20 children).

The multi-purpose room 170: 3,114 square feet. The multi-purpose room was not used in determining the center's total capacity.

The children will be using the boys' and girls' bathrooms down the hall from room 130. There are seven toilets, two urinals and six sinks available. Staff will be providing direct supervision in the bathrooms.

### B. Program Description

This is a full day program serving children ages 2 years 6 months through 5 years 11 months. The facility operates Monday through Friday 7:45 am – 3:30 pm. The program will offer learning experiences that focus on social interaction, creativity, literacy, and early science and math. There is a variety of age appropriate play equipment and materials.

A playground inspection was completed on 09/18/2018 and the multi-use composite structure was approved for children ages 2 years through 5 years.

Gross motor activities will also be held in the multi-purpose room when it is available.


Breakfast and lunch are provided by Pickford Public Schools. Snacks are provided by the facility.

Transportation is provided by Pickford Public Schools.

On 07/23/2019 a lead hazard risk assessment was completed on the following areas: room 132, the boys' and girls' restrooms, multi-purpose room 170, gym room 148, and playground. Zero existing lead hazards were identified. Room 133 was added in 1996; therefore, no lead risk assessment was required. Room 188 and the boys' and girls' restrooms located in the same hallway were added in 1989; therefore, no lead risk assessment was required. On 08/17/2022 a lead risk assessment was completed on room 130. No lead hazards were identified.

**V. Recommendation**

I recommend room 130 be approved as child use space.
