III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection the programming I observed included the following: nap time, toileting and free play. I observed the caregivers’ interactions with the children in care to be developmentally appropriate and responsive to their needs.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the exit conference, I provided technical assistance and consultation regarding posting breakfast menus.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an "A" rated environmental health inspection, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
