On 12/18/2023 I observed mouse feces behind a bookshelf and in a closet in Room 3. Child care staff member 9 observed the mouse droppings in Room 3 behind the bookshelf that morning, but nothing was done. I was on-site at approximately 11:00 am – 12:30 pm and the mouse droppings were still present in the classroom where children were present.	All staff will be reminded of & re-trained in their cleaning responsibilities. Any mess that poses a threat to health and safety of anyone will be cleaned immediately. Supervisor will be notified of any mouse droppings and or sightings immediately.	02/06/2024


R 400.8380(2)	Licensee Amy J Scott-Kronemeyer did not ensure the premises was maintained as to eliminate and prevent rodent harborage. . Staff members have observed mice and mouse feces for several months. Mouse traps are set nightly in the kitchen and hallways. On 12/18/2023 I observed mouse feces behind a bookshelf and in a closet in Room 3.	All food items must be stored in rubbermaid storage containers.	immediately
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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
