II. Purpose of Addendum

On 07/03/2023, licensee designee Ms. Caron Stanton requested the removal of the **Farwell East** room from the approved child care space; and a decrease in capacity from 60 to 40 children, ages 30 months and above.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

A. Description of Facility: The child care center is located in the child care wing of the Farwell Elementary School in Farwell, Michigan.

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):

Farwell North: This room is temporarily labeled #514 and measures 34 ft. x 36 ft. (1224 sq. ft.) There is a 6 ft. x 8 ft. (48 sq. ft.) bathroom that protrudes into this and has been deduced from the child use space. Total available area for children is 1176 sq. ft. This supports the requested capacity of 20 children ages 30 months and above.

Farwell West: This room is temporarily labeled #512 and measures 34 ft. x 36 ft. (1224 sq. ft.) There is a 6 ft. x 8 ft. (48 sq. ft.) bathroom that protrudes into this and has been deduced from the child use space. Total available area for children is 1176 sq. ft. This supports the requested capacity of 20 children ages 30 months and above.

The total space is sufficient for a total center capacity of 40 children, age 30 months and above.

Equipment: There is an adequate amount of play and learning equipment available to support the capacity of 40 children.

Number of sinks and toilets: A total of three toilets and three hand washing sinks are available. This supports the centers capacity of 40 children.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards: The outdoor play area is located adjacent to the school building and contains permanently installed equipment. It is surrounded by a chain link fence. There are no nearby water hazards.

An environmental health inspection, a lead hazard risk assessment and a certification of school building fire safety were not required for this modification.


Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 40 children, age 30 months and above.

Transportation and food service will be provided via contract with local vendors. Swimming will not be offered.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the removal of the **Farwell East** room from the approved child use space; and a decrease in the center's total center capacity from 60 to 40 children, ages 30 month and above.


