

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection I observed free choice, infant care, diapering, rest time, snack, story time, and children transitioning to outdoor play. Appropriate transitions were observed between each activity. Child care staff engaged with children and worked as a team in each classroom. Classrooms are well organized, inviting, and have a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate equipment for the children to choose from. Ms. Sullivan along with child care staff have created classrooms rich

in learning opportunities. While onsite, I reviewed five staff files and ten children's files, emergency plans, discipline policy, and the center's policy for screening and supervision of volunteers. Ms. Sullivan has paperwork extremely organized and complete.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
