

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

When I arrived for the inspection, three child care staff members and one supervised volunteer were providing care to twenty four children. The children were engaged in free choice time. Child care staff moved throughout the classroom, providing support to children's learning experiences. Staff used appropriate communication skills with children, enhancing their language development.

Classrooms are well organized, inviting and have a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate equipment for the children to choose from.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8125                      Staff; volunteer; requirements.**

(5) A written statement must be signed and dated by staff and volunteers at the time of hiring or before volunteering indicating all of the following information:

(a) The individual is aware that abuse and neglect of children is against the law.

(b) The individual has been informed of the center's policies on child abuse and neglect.

(c) The individual knows that all staff and volunteers are required by law to immediately report suspected abuse and neglect to children's protective services.

Ms. Kinsey did not ensure a supervised volunteer, prior to volunteering, signed an abuse and neglect statement indicating all of the following:

- The individual is aware that abuse and neglect of children is against the law.
- The individual has been informed of the center's policies on child abuse and neglect.
- The individual knows that all staff and volunteers are required by law to immediately report suspected abuse and neglect to children's protective services.

**R 400.8143                      Children's records.**

(6) Within 30 days of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain, keep on file, and make accessible in the center a record of a physical evaluation of the child that notes any restrictions and is signed by a physician or the physician's designee. An electronic record from a physician's office will be accepted. The physical evaluation must be performed within 1 of the following time limits:

(c) For preschoolers, within the preceding 12 months.


Ms. Kinsey did not ensure one child enrolled in care had a physical evaluation signed by a physician or physician's designee within 30 days of the child's initial attendance.

**Technical assistance was provided for the following:**

- Have parents/guardians complete work section on child information card or write "none", whichever applies.
- Children's water bottles; one day use then must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized before use again.
- Complete PSOR on student volunteer that is 17 years old.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
