

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

When I arrived for the inspection, three child care staff members were providing care to twenty-four children. During the inspection I observed the following:

- Free choice,
- Clean up
- Handwashing

- Large group movement
- Small group
- Lunch
- Preparation for rest time for children
- Exiting of children that do not remain in care in the afternoon
- Transitions between activities

Child care staff moved throughout the classroom, providing support to children's learning experiences. Staff used appropriate communication skills with children, enhancing their language development. Classrooms are well organized, inviting and have a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate equipment for the children to choose from.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
