- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

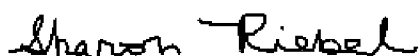
Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, a regular license will be issued. You will receive it in the mail.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection I observed AM snack, rest time, free choice, small group time, and lunch. All the rooms were set up well with a large variety of age-appropriate materials and equipment. Child care staff members interacted with children in a positive and friendly manner. I heard them use positive discipline strategies. All the groups were following ratio and group size requirements. The programming they offered was educational and the children seemed interested and

engaged. Center, child, and staff records were organized and made readily available.

I provided technical assistance and consultation on the following rules:

- R 400.8161(2)(f) Emergency procedures.
- R 400.8530(10) Hazard areas.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

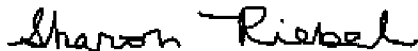
R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

(3) All medication must be in its original container, stored according to instructions, and clearly labeled for a named child, including all nonprescription medications described in subrule (8) of this rule.

The license designee, Ms. Laskowski, did not ensure medications were clearly labeled for the children they were intended. I found two tubes of diaper cream that were not labeled with children's names.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon the receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
