R 400.8380(1)	During the inspection, I found a bottle of sunscreen and a package of diaper wipes accessible to children in the cupboard adjacent to the handwashing sink in the Ram's classroom.	The program director placed a child safety lock on the cupboard the same day as the violation. To maintain compliance, all cupboards/drawers/cabinets will have a child safety lock on them to ensure no item that poses a safety concern will be accessible to the children when put away.	09/07/2022 Ongoing

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
