IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have previously been modified on 01/28/2021, 09/08/2017, and 10/21/2013.

The center is located in the Alanson Littlefield Public School building. The center is comprised of one classroom and a multipurpose room.

The following rooms are approved for use and were used to determine the center's capacity:

- **Classroom 101:** This room was previously measured to be 30ft. x 28.5ft. and 16.5ft. x 7.5ft., providing for a total area of 978 square feet. This is sufficient space for the capacity of 18 child care children ages 30 months to 6 years.

The licensee designee understands that if there is a mixed age group in the room, the ratio of caregiver to children is based on the youngest child.

The total space is sufficient for a total center capacity of 18 children ages 30 months through six years.

The following rooms are approved as additional child use space and were not used to determine the center's total capacity:

- **Multi-purpose room:** This room measured to be 59.6 ft. x 51 ft., providing for a total of 3039 square feet. This is sufficient space for the center's total capacity of 18 children 30 months and above.

The classroom has a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment to support physical, social, emotional, and cognitive developmental as well as imaginative play, language, literacy, creativity, early math, and early science experiences.

The outdoor play area is entirely fenced in and it is adjacent to the center's entrance. The children have access to various outdoor play equipment and toys. The playground was inspected on 11/02/2011.

An Environmental Health Inspection with an A rating occurred on 02/27/2019. The Fire Safety Provisions form was signed by the superintendent on 01/26/2021. On 01/28/2021, I received a statement from Ms. Dukes stating that child care children do not access any part of the old building and they would ensure children only utilize the remodeled part of the school.

Number of sinks and toilets: There is one toilet and two sinks in the classroom available for the children's use. There are also hallway bathrooms nearby which the child care children can use. The girls' room has seven stalls and three sinks and the boys' room has three stalls, four urinals and three sinks.

Terms:

The center is located in the Littlefield Elementary School in Alanson. The center consists of one classroom and a multi-purpose room.

- The center operates 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM full day.

The center does not have food service as a program component. NMCAA contracts with the Littlefield Elementary School. Therefore, children receive breakfast, lunch, and an afternoon snack.

The center does not have swimming or transportation as program components.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the change in hours of operation to 8:00 AM to 03:00 PM.
