III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, there were 22 children present with two child care staff members. While onsite, I observed snack time, programming, and outdoor play. All of the children and child care staff members were wearing a face mask. I observed child care staff members offering children options with tasks. I witnessed an activity where the children provide details in an interactive story with each child having a turn to include their own details to the story. Ms. Mulkey was very engaged with the

children. Both child care staff members were positively redirecting behavior and enforcing safety rules with all of the children in care. The children have access to a large outdoor play area adjacent to the school. The outdoor play area features climbers, slides, swings, and various other outdoor play equipment.


The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.
