II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum is to add Room #28 as use space with no change in capacity, at the request of the licensee.

III. Methodology

02/16/2023- Received modification request to add classroom 28 for 4-year-olds.

05/11/2023 – Inspection completed onsite.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The original terms of the license were modified on July 21, 2023, May 18, 2017.

Holy Family Preschool and Extended Care is located within Holy Family Catholic School in Grand Blanc. The school currently houses kindergarten through 6th grade.

On May 11, 2023, I inspected Room #28.

- Room 28 measures 26ft x 34ft, providing a total of 884 square feet. This space can accommodate up to 25 children ages 2.5 and above. The licensee designee understands that if there is a mixed age group in this room, that the ratio is based on the ratio requirements of the youngest child.

The following areas were previously inspected and approved:

- Room 5 is 30ft x 30ft, providing a total of 900 square feet. This can accommodate up to 26 children ages 2.5 and older.
- Room 30 is 28ft x 28ft providing a total of 784 square feet. This can accommodate up to 22 children ages 2.5 and older.
- Room 36 is 34ft x 24ft providing a total of 816 square feet. This can accommodate up to 23 children ages 2.5 and older.

The following rooms are approved as additional child use space and were not used to determine the center's total capacity:

- The gym is approximately 6,000 square feet and can accommodate the center's capacity.
- The cafeteria is approximately 3,000 square feet and can accommodate the center's capacity.

The total space is sufficient for a requested center capacity of 59 children, ages 2.5 to 12 years. There is a total of 13 handwashing sinks, 10 toilets and 3 urinals adjacent to the child care space. This support's the center's capacity.

The classrooms are furnished with a wide variety of developmentally appropriate equipment and there is an adequate amount of equipment to support the capacity of the center.

There is a large fenced outdoor play area located in the courtyard behind the school. There is a large play structure, which was inspected and approved on May 15, 2015.

The school kitchen is licensed and approved annually by the Genesee County Health Department; therefore, an environmental health inspection was not required. The school superintendent provided a fire safety sign-off on August 04, 2022. On July 24, 2014, a lead hazard risk assessment was completed on Room 30. No lead risk was found. Rooms 5, 26 and 28 did not require a lead risk assessment as they were built in 1981. The gym was built in 2000.


Lunch will be provided by the school for children staying for extended care. Parent provide the snack for children in care.

Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 59 children age 2.5 through 12 years.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of Room 28 as approved child use space. The capacity will remain at 59.
