### Findings of the Inspection



R 400.8125(5)(c)	The individual knows that all staff and volunteers are required by law to immediately report suspected abuse and neglect to children's protective services.
R 400.8125(5)	A written statement must be signed and dated by staff and volunteers at the time of hiring or before volunteering indicating all of the following information:
R 400.8125(5)(a)	The individual is aware that abuse and neglect of children is against the law.
R 400.8125(5)(b)	The individual has been informed of the center's policies on child abuse and neglect.

R 400.8131(1)	The center shall provide an orientation about the center's policies and practices and these administrative rules for all personnel hired after the effective date of these rules and before unsupervised contact with children.
R 400.8161(8)	Each child care staff member shall be trained at least twice a year on his or her duties and responsibilities for all emergency procedures referenced in subrule (1) of this rule.
R 400.8134(2)(e)	After each diapering.
R 400.8112(2)(e)	Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.
