II. Purpose of Addendum

On August 9, 2022, Kelli Webb, licensee designee requested to remove Classroom 13 from the list of child approved use spaces and change Classroom 19 from Early Head Start to Head Start.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on July 13, 2012, September 2, 2015, and June 17, 2016, October 19, 2017, October 17, 2018, June 18, 2019, August 9, 2019, February 14, 2020, and August 18, 2022.

The following spaces were previously approved:

- Classroom 11 (Head Start) is 26 ft. x 25 ft., providing a total of 650 square feet. This space is sufficient for a capacity of 18 children aged 2.5-6 years.
- Classroom 12 (Head Start) is 26 ft. x 25 ft., providing a total of 650 square feet. This space is sufficient for a capacity of 18 children aged 2.5-6 years.
- Classroom 14 (Early Head Start) is 26 ft. x 25 ft., providing a total of 650 square feet. This space is sufficient for the requested capacity of 8 children aged birth-3 years.
- Classroom 15 (Early Head Start) is 26 ft. x 28 ft., providing a total of 728 square feet. This space is sufficient for the requested capacity of 8 children aged birth-3 years.
- Classroom 17 (Early Head Start) is 26 ft. x 25 ft., providing a total of 650 square feet. This space is sufficient for the requested capacity of 8 children aged birth-3 years.

The following room is approved as additional child use space and was not used to determine the center's total capacity:

- Gymnasium is 46 ft. x 56 ft. providing a total of 2,576 square feet. The capacity of the space is based on the age of the group utilizing the space. The capacity for children aged birth-2.5 years is 12. The capacity for children aged 2.5-4 years is 30. The capacity for children aged 4-6 years is

36. The licensee designee understands that if the group sizes exceed the allowed number based on age, the space must be split into two distinct use spaces. The gymnasium will not be counted in the center's capacity.

The licensee designee understands that the maximum group size and ratio is based on the age of the youngest child utilizing the space.

On August 18, 2022, I inspection Classroom 13:

- Classroom 13 (Head Start) is 26 ft. x 25 ft., providing a total of 650 square feet. This space is sufficient for the requested capacity of 18 children aged 2.5-6 years.

Each Classroom has two sinks. There are additional bathrooms located throughout the facility. There are a total of 8 sinks, 3 urinals, and 9 toilets available for use. This supports the facility capacity of 78 children aged Birth-6 years.

The classrooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment and materials.

The outdoor play area is located behind the school. The area is not fenced does not contain any water hazards. A playground safety inspection was completed on October 6, 2021. The licensee designee understands that classrooms can only use the equipment designated appropriate for their age group and direct supervision will be provided at all times.

A lead assessment was completed on June 15, 2011, June 28, 2011, December 3, 2014, August 29, 2017, and July 31, 2019. The facility was determined to be safe for child occupancy. No lead-based hazards were identified.

An "A" rated Fire Safety Inspection was completed on January 8, 2022. An "A" rated Environmental Health Inspection was completed on February 8, 2022.

Terms

The facility is approved for 78 children aged birth-6 years. The facility provides full meal service catered through the school district. Transportation and swimming are not available.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the removal of Classroom 19 and the change in use space for Classroom 13 from Early Head Start to Head Start. I recommend a reduction in capacity from 86 to 78 children aged Birth-6 years.
