Dear Dr. Summey:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 05/31/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8315 Food and equipment storage.

(1) Each refrigerator must have an accurate working thermometer indicating a temperature of 41 degrees Fahrenheit or below.

Upon my arrival at the center, the thermometer in the refrigerator in one of the rooms indicated a temperature of 50 degrees Fahrenheit. I notified a child care staff member who immediately lowered the temperature of the refrigerator. Prior to leaving the center, I re-checked the thermometer, and it continued to indicate a temperature of 50 degrees Fahrenheit.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 06/22/2023. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.

- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.


