
R 400.8140(2)(a)	Asia Moore popped child on the hand and made them sit in a seat.	Licensee will ensure all child care staff members no not use physical discipline towards children.	2/14/2024
R 400.8110(7)	Diane Branch and Amanda Weir allowed a child to leave the room with someone not authorized by the parent on the child information card.	Licensee will ensure children are only released to a person authorized by the parent.	2/14/2024

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
