Dear Ms Keels:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 05/04/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

I observed children engaged in nap time, handwashing, and parent drop off. The children appeared happy and bonded, and caregivers were nurturing and caring.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8112 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

(1) Pursuant to section 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, before an individual has unsupervised contact with children, the department shall determine the individual's eligibility to be any of the following:

(c) A child care staff member.

There is a staff member JaSonya Garnett is not listed on the CCBC.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(10) All child care staff members who work directly with children are required to be trained in first aid and pediatric, child, and adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) within 90 days of being hired. Prior to issuing a license to operate a child care center, and prior to the renewal of a license, the department shall verify that at least 50% of the child care staff members who work directly with children are currently certified in first aid and pediatric, child, and adult CPR. Each of these child care staff member's first aid and CPR certificates must be valid and retained on file in the center.

There is no documentation of training of CPR and First aid adult/pediatric for Angela Johnson or Wanisha Conklin.

R 400.8176 Sleeping equipment.

(18) All occupied cribs, porta-cribs, cots, and mats must be placed in such a manner that there is a free and direct means of egress and must be spaced as follows:

(a) Cribs and porta-cribs must be at least 2 feet apart. Cribs or porta-cribs with solid-panel ends may be placed end-to-end.

The cribs are lined up side by side and touching, they are not two feet apart.

R 400.8185 Primary care.

(2) The center shall implement a primary care system so that each infant and toddler has a primary caregiver.

The infant room is not documenting or keeping accurate track of primary care.

R 400.8335 Food services and nutrition; provided by center.

(8) All of the following apply to milk:

(a) Containers must be labeled with the date opened.

The milk in the infant room is opened and not dated.

R 400.8340

Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.

(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.

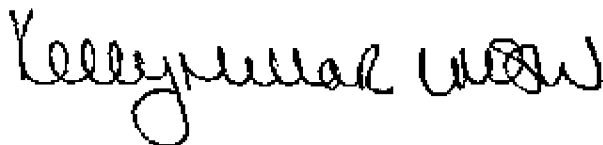
The bottles and cups in the infant room are not labeled first name, last name, and date.

On 5/4/2023, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.

The Department provides technical assistance to meet the licensing requirements and consultation to improve services.
