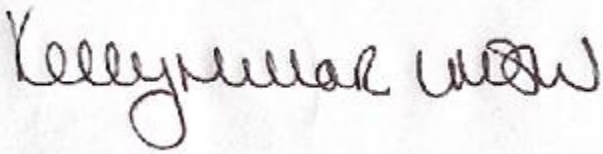

Technical Assistance	
Rule Number	Rule
R 400.8161(8)	Each child care staff member shall be trained at least twice a year on his or her duties and responsibilities for all emergency procedures referenced in subrule (1) of this rule. Licensee will ensure she has documentation of training staff twice a year on emergency procedures.
R 400.8143(1)	At the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain a child information card, using a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute, that is completed and signed by the child's parent. The center shall keep it on file and accessible in the center. Licensee will ensure all child information cards are filled out in their entirety including date of admission, correct date of birth and doctors phone number.
R 400.8161(6)	A tornado drill program, consisting of at least 2 tornado drills between the months of March through November, must be established and implemented. Licensee will ensure two tornado drills twice a month are completed/documented.
R 400.8330(22)	Infants or toddlers shall not have bottles, beverage containers, or food in sleeping equipment. Licensee will ensure infants or toddlers will not lay down with bottles in the cribs.
R 400.8137(1)(c)	Has non-absorbent, smooth, easily cleanable surfaces in good repair. Licensee will ensure there are no rips/tears in the diaper pad.
