### Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the renewal inspection, licensing consultant Kelly Millar found 6 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 12/05/2023. A regular license will be issued.

Due to the infant safe sleep violation(s), all of the facility's infant child care staff members must take training on infant safe sleep. This must be included in the facility's corrective action plan and completed by 12/20/2023. In addition, a follow up inspection may be made to check compliance with the infant safe sleep rules.


R 400.8161(8)	Each child care staff member shall be trained at least twice a year on his or her duties and responsibilities for all emergency procedures referenced in subrule (1) of this rule.
R 400.8131(5)	Within 90 days of being hired, or the first day as an unsupervised volunteer, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall complete the following trainings, which may count toward annual professional development hours and are available at MiRegistry:
R 400.8143(8)(c)	The immunization record or appropriate waiver is on file with the child's school.
R 400.8161(5)	A fire drill program, consisting of at least 1 fire drill quarterly, must be established and implemented.
R 400.8340(7)	Milk and other beverages furnished in a multi-day supply must be labeled with the child's first and last name and the date of opening and be returned to the parent or discarded 7 days after opening.
