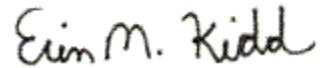

I understand that an individual found ineligible may not be associated as a household member or staff with my facility. I understand that the department may seek disciplinary action against my child care license in the form of a revocation and/or summary suspension with revocation if I continue to allow an individual found ineligible to be associated with my child care license. I understand that if I fail to complete, return and/or comply with this Corrective Action Plan or request for Voluntary Closure, the department will begin the process of revoking my child care license	
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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
