R 400.8112(2)	Ms. Payne did not disconnect multiple child care staff members from the Child Care Background Check System that were no longer employed.	Ms. Payne will be sure to disconnect CCSM's from the CCBC system within 24 hours of no longer being employed. These individuals were disconnected.	10/30/2023
R 400.8340(3)	The center had bottles and beverage containers in the refrigerator in the infant/toddler room that were not labeled with the child's first and last name and/or date.	Ms. Payne will make sure that all bottles and beverage containers are labeled appropriately.	10/04/2023
R 400.8330(5)	I observed that the center did not have adequate staff present during lunch, ensuring that food service activities did not distract from the supervision of children.	Ms. Payne will make sure she has enough staff present during mealtimes.	10/05/2023
R 400.8335(8)	I observed open containers of milk, in the infant/toddler refrigerator, that were not labeled with the date opened.	Ms. Payne will assure that open milk containers are labeled appropriately.	10/04/2023
