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
R 400.8128 Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.	2 Staff did not have TB test results on file.	Ms. Searcy believes that 1 of the staff has TB test results at her family home child care and the other one is a brand new staff member and will be obtaining this.	One month
R 400.8137 Diapering; toileting.	The diaper pad was torn and needs replacement. The 3 step system was not being used on the diaper pad.	Ms. Searcy will replace the diaper changing pad and was not aware that the 3-step system used on multi-purpose tables must also be used on diaper changing pads.	Immediately for the 3-step system used for cleaning the diaper changing pad and 1 day for the diaper changing pad replacement.
R 400.8143 Children's records.	2 of 10 children's records reviewed did not have up-to-date immunization records; None of the 10 children's files reviewed had a physical.	Ms. Searcy was under the impression that a parent could sign acknowledgement that the child is in good health, like they do in licensed family and group homes. Ms. Searcy will obtain physicals and updated immunization records for all children in care.	One month for parents to provide the required documentation.
R 400.8335(4) Food services and nutrition; provided by center.	Children under 2 years were being served 2% milk for lunch.	Ms. Searcy was not aware of the requirement of whole milk be served for children under 2, as well as that children over 2 must be served skim, ½ % or 1 % milk.	This would be corrected the next day child care is in session.

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
