III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

The SPARKS afterschool program is located in Gladwin Elementary School.

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):

Classroom 5 is measured at 42 ft x 32 ft = 1, 344 sq. ft. This space can accommodate up to 38 children ages 5 to 12 years.

Classroom 9 is measured at 27 ft. x 39 ft = 1, 053 sq. ft. This space can accommodate up to 30 children ages 5 to 12 years.

Classroom 12 is measured at 25 ft. x 37 ft. = 925 sq. ft. This space can accommodate up to 26 children ages 5 to 12 years.

Classroom 11 is measured at 24 ft. x 38 ft. = 912 sq. ft. This space can accommodate up to 26 children ages 5 to 12 years.

Classroom 13 is measured at 31 ft. x 28 ft. = 868 sq. ft. This space can accommodate up to 24 ages 5 to 12 years.

Classroom 14 is measured at 35 ft. x 28 ft. = 980 sq. ft. This space can accommodate up to 28 children, ages 5 to 12 years.

Classroom 16 is measured at 36 ft. x 30 ft. = 1080 sq. ft. This space can accommodate up to 30 children, ages 5 to 12 years.

Classroom 15 is measured at 26 ft. x 37 ft. = 962 sq. ft. This space can accommodate up to 27 children, ages 5 to 12 years.

Gym is measured at 45 ft x 75 ft = 3,375 sq. ft. This space is not used in determining the total center capacity but can accommodate the licensed capacity of 45 children.

Cafeteria is measured at 35 ft. x 48 ft. = 1,680 sq. ft. This space is not used in determining the total center capacity but can accommodate the licensed capacity of 45 children.

Library is measured at 42 ft. x 39 ft. = 1,638 sq. ft. This space is not used in determining the total center capacity but can accommodate the licensed capacity of 45 children.

Equipment: The center has a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment and sufficient supply to accommodate the requested capacity of 45 children ages 5 to 12 years.

Number of sinks and toilets: There are a total of eight toilets and twelve sinks. Classroom 12, Classroom 11, Classroom 13, Classroom 16, and Classroom 15 all have one toilet and one sink. The girl's bathroom located in the hallway has two toilets and two sinks. The boy's bathroom has one toilet, one urinal and two sinks. This supports the center's capacity of 45 children.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards: The outdoor play area is located behind the school. The outdoor play area has sufficient ground covering. There are no water hazards located around or near the outdoor play area.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results: A lead hazard risk assessment was completed on 08/05/2022. The locations tested were the cafeteria, girl's bathroom, boy's bathroom, and library. No lead hazards were present. The other additions to the school were not assessed as they were additions after 1978.

Documentation of playground safety: The playground has sufficient ground covering and the equipment is free from hazards. A playground inspection is not required for this program under R400.8170 (12). The licensee understands parents must be informed in writing at the time of enrollment that the center plans to use the school's outdoor play area and equipment which may not comply with R400.8170(11).

B. Program Description

Ages of children served: This facility serves school age children, ages 5 to 12 years.

Proposed days and hours of operation: This facility will operate Monday through Thursday from 3:15 pm to 6 pm.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both): This facility is a part time after school program.

Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service: This facility offers after school programming. Transportation is provided by the school district.

Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified:
The program director is Kelly Humphry who is qualified through R400.8113(8)(a) and(9).

Is there a central administrator that meets the administrative requirement? There is no central administrator.

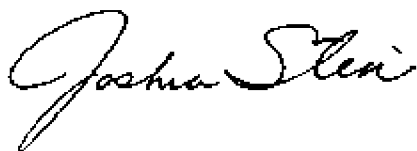
Explanation of variance(s), if any: There are no approved variances for this facility.

I recommend issuance of an original license to this child care center.

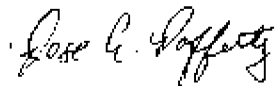
