Ms. Schopieray reported that Ms. Martin and Ms. Luther completed the MiRegistry Refreshers and the completed trainings have been added to their training logs. To maintain compliance, the program director will review staff trainings three times a year.	2/25/2023
R 400.8161(5)	During the inspection, I found that a fire drill was not conducted between May – August of 2022.	The program director will schedule fire drills three months in advance using a calendar and drill form. The program director will check fire and tornado drills	02/16/2023

		quarterly to ensure they have been completed within the required timeframes.	
R 400.8176(1)	During the inspection, I observed a hole in a sheet on a porta-crib in the infant classroom.	Ms. Schopieray reported that Ms. Martin threw away the torn sheet during the inspection. To maintain compliance, the lead teacher will check bedding each day prior to placing children down for naps to ensure the sheets are in good repair.	02/16/2023
R 400.8330(24)(c)	During the inspection, I observed child care staff members Tesla Martin and Kaylee Darling not sitting with toddlers during lunch time.	The program director will check the infant/toddler classroom during lunch and snack time at least once a week to ensure one staff member is sitting with children during meals.	02/16/2023
R 400.8350(5)	During the inspection, I recorded the water temperature in the infant classroom handwashing sink at 123.1 degrees Fahrenheit.	Ms. Schopieray reported that she has ordered a water regulator for the handwashing sink, and she spoke to the janitor about the water temperature. The lead teacher will monitor handwashing in the infant/toddler classroom until the water temperature is turned below 120 degrees Fahrenheit. To maintain compliance, the program director will check the water temperature twice a year.	02/16/2023

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
