II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum is to modify currently approved use space at the facility.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license were modification on, 6/26//2017, 1/3/2018, 1/29/2018, 2/1/2019, 2/12/2019, 10/2/2019, 9/29/2020, August 31, 2021, and April 4, 2022.

North Huron Early Childhood Center is located in North Huron Elementary School, which currently houses grades Kindergarten through 5th grade.

The following spaces were previously inspected and approved:

- Room 107 is 25 ft. x 27 ft., providing a total of 675 square feet. This can accommodate 19 children aged 5-12 years. This space is only approved for school age children.
- Room 114 is 29 ft. x 26 ft., providing a total of 754 square feet. This can accommodate up to 22 children aged 2.5-12 years.
- Room 115 is 27 ft. x 22 ft, 17 ft. x 15 ft., and 8 ft. X 8 ft. providing a total of 913 square feet. This can accommodate up to 26 children aged 2.5-12 years.
- Room 116 is 27 ft. x 8 ft., and 22 ft. x 24 ft., providing a total of 744 square feet. Based on the group size for infants and toddlers, this space can accommodate up to 12 children ages birth through 2.5 years. (a partial wall was added during renovations to separate the nap area.)
- Room 117 is 32 ft. x 25 ft., providing a total of 800 square feet. This can accommodate up to 23 children aged 2.5-12 years.
- Room 118 is 32 ft. x 22 ft., plus 26 ft. x 3 ft., plus 22 ft. x 2 ft., providing a total of 826 square feet. Based on the group size for infants and toddlers,

this space can accommodate up to 12 children ages birth through 2.5 years.

- Room 119 is 32 ft. x 26 ft., providing a total of 832 square feet. This can accommodate up to 24 children aged birth-12 years. (If room 119 is used for children under 2.5 years of age, the capacity is 12, based on the group size for infants and toddlers.)

The following rooms are approved as additional use space and were not used to determine the center's total capacity:

- The library is 73 ft. x 55 ft., providing a total of 4,015 square feet. This can accommodate up to 36 children aged 2.5-12 years, or up to 12 children birth to 2.5 years.
- The media center is 39 ft. x 21 ft., providing a total of 819 square feet. This can accommodate up to 23 children aged 2.5-12 years or up to 12 children ages birth through 2.5 years.
- The cafeteria is 94 ft. x 31 ft., providing a total of 2,914 square feet. This will accommodate up to 36 children 2.5-12 years or up to 12 children birth to 2.5 years.
- The new gym is 100 ft. x 94 ft., providing a total of 9,400 square feet. . This will accommodate up to 36 children 2.5-12 years or up to 12 children birth to 2.5 years.
- The multipurpose room (old gym) is 61 ft. x 39 ft., providing a total of 2,379 square feet. This can accommodate 12 children birth to 2.5 years, or up to 36 children aged 2.5-12 years. (The room includes several educational stations, including literacy, STEM, and gross motor. Present in the room is an area recessed by elevated foam padding. The area is intended for STEM activities. The space of this area is appropriate for no more than three children aged birth-2.5 years or four children aged 2.5-12 years.)
- Room 110 is 25 ft. x 27 ft., providing a total of 675 square feet. This can accommodate 19 children aged 3-12 years. This room is now being used to support social emotional health of students and will not count toward the overall capacity of the facility.

On April 1, 2022, I inspected Room 120, which will be used for a toddler classroom.

- Room 120 is 32 ft. x 26 ft., providing a total of 832 square feet. Based on the group size for infants and toddlers, this space can accommodate up to 12 children ages 1 through 3 years.

The licensee designee understands that the capacity and group size of a use space is based on the age of the youngest child utilizing that space. The total space is sufficient for a total requested center capacity of 150 children, birth-12 years.

There is a total of 22 handwashing sinks, 25 toilets, and 6 urinals. This supports the center's licensed capacity.

The infant/toddler classrooms (Room 116, Room 118, and Room 120) have a designated handwashing sink for diapering. The classrooms are furnished with a wide variety of age-appropriate equipment. There is an adequate amount of equipment to support the capacity of the facility.

A lead hazard risk assessment was completed on May 1, 2016, and August 27, 2019. No lead hazards were identified. A fire inspection is not required as the center is located in a school. An "A" rated environmental health inspection was completed at original issuance, on January 14, 2019, August 16, 2020, and March 30, 2022. New inspections are not required.

Terms:

The facility is approved for a total capacity of 150 children aged birth-12 years. Meals will be provided by parents or children will have the option of purchasing lunch provided by the school. Transportation may be available through the school district. Swimming will not be provided.

V. Recommendation

I recommend a change in use space for Room 120 and an increase in capacity from 138 to 150 children aged birth-12 years.
