
		<p>Bus logs and attendance logs are cross checked. All preschool staff are expected to ensure their children are accounted for throughout the transition time at the end of the day. Upon leaving the playground, imagination station or any area transitioning from Point A to Point B, A "sweep" of the departed is mandatory program directors, periodically monitor transitions weekly.</p>	
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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
