**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.**

**(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.**

At the time of the onsite inspection, Mya Klemmer, Whitney Hoppe, Jenna Barnes and Nick Eisinger, child care staff members, were lacking training on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

**R 400.8143 Children's records.**

**(3) For children under school-age, at the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain, keep on file, and make accessible in the center 1 of the following:**

**(a) A certificate of immunization showing a minimum of 1 dose of each immunizing agent specified by the department of health and human services (DHHS).**

At the time of the onsite inspection, three of ten children's files reviewed were lacking a certificate of immunization showing a minimum of 1 dose of each immunizing agent specified by the department of health and human services (DHHS).

**R 400.8320 Food preparation.**

**(5) Ready to eat foods must not be prepared or served using bare hands.**

During the onsite inspection, I observed Teri Johnson, child care staff member, serve a banana with bare hands.

- On February 25, 2022, I provided technical assistance to Sarah Brooks regarding medications that require a doctor's written dosing instructions. Benadryl was observed in the Wobbler Room and had not yet been given to the child. The Benadryl will not be given without a doctor's written instructions. I provided technical assistance on items hanging from the ceiling in the Preschool Room. The items will be removed. I provided technical assistance on bottle warming for the Wobbler Room and redirection for Wobbler age children.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/01/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
