Dear Ms. Pohl:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 02/24/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the onsite inspection I observed free choice, hand washing, toileting, diapering, and lunch. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate. Technical assistance was given on pacifiers, MiRegistry refreshers, classroom management, stand up diapering and classroom safety.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

- (3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

One child care staff member in the infant room was not trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect before caring for children.

R 400.8131

Professional development requirements.

- (4) Before unsupervised contact with children, all child care staff members who work directly with children shall complete prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations.

One child care staff member in the infant room did not complete prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations before unsupervised contact with children.

On 02/24/2023, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.
