**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection I observed arrival, breakfast, free choice, hand washing, diapering, toileting, outside time, and snack time. Child care staff members in all

classrooms were engaged with the children. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8134            Hand washing.**

**(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times:**

**(c) After handling animals and pets.**

Three children in the P1 classroom but did not wash their hands after handling the pet rabbit in the classroom.

Technical assistance was given on water bottles, emergency procedures, training requirements, and Epi-Pens.

#### **IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
