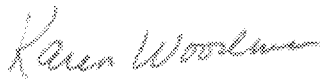

R 400.8385	There were poisonous or toxic materials found in the cabinets under the sinks that were not locked or stored out of the reach of children in two classrooms.	The toxic materials under the sinks were immediately removed from the children's reach. Additional cabinet locks were purchased on 4/25/2023 to put on any cabinets with toxic materials. If cabinet locks are not used, toxic materials will be moved out of the reach of children. Teachers will conduct a daily morning inspection of the classrooms to make sure that toxic materials are out of the reach of children. The program director will monitor the classrooms monthly to ensure there are no toxic materials within the reach of children. All new child care staff members will be trained at orientation on keeping toxic materials out of the reach of children.	05/25/2023

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
