III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

Child care staff members did not complete Health and Safety Refreshers 2020 and 2021 on MiRegistry within six months of the notice.

During my onsite visit, I observed arrival, snack, handwashing, outside time and departure. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate.

Technical assistance was given on child information cards, emergency plans and training hours.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
