We held a full staff meeting/training on reporting behavior on 9/21/2022 for 2 hours. Another professional development training called "How to Help" happened on 10/12/2022.</p>

All child care staff members interviewed said that Ms. Terrell doesn't yell at the children but makes inappropriate and humiliating comments to them.</p>	<p>Child care staff members will use positive messages/wording and actions for discipline that will encourage self-control and help build self-esteem. Our school/child care center has started a Positivity Project that has weekly groups, messages and ideas for all child care staff members and students. This is a weekly project that will continue throughout the school year. Every August our school will have a refresher course on Positivity Training.</p>	10/03/2022
