The policy does not state how and when parents will be notified when their child experiences an incident and incidents are	Ms. Wills stated she provided Child A's Mother with a written report. Moving forward all reports will be provided to the parent at pick up. Ms. Wills and/or Ms. Bailey will be responsible for this. All child care staff members have been trained on incident reporting and all new staff will be trained on incident reporting. The updated policy will contain all components required by licensing including stating how and when parents will be noticed	Immediately and ongoing.


