III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(1) The premises must be maintained in a clean and safe condition and must not pose a threat to health or safety.

The deck surrounding the building has slats that are loose and have a hazard of coming up. This concern has been known since December 13, 2021, special investigation in which it was a violation.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(4) Floors, interior walls, and ceilings must be kept in sound condition, good repair, and maintained in a clean condition.

There were classrooms with water stains and/or holes on the ceiling tiles. There are exposed seams in the carpet in the common area of the center. The environmental health inspection report dated 02/07/2020 and 07/14/2020 states there are exposed seams in the carpet in the common area and this should be properly repaired or replaced. In a classroom there was trim which was disconnected and/or missing.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(5) There must be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces or on equipment accessible to children.

There was flaking paint on the classroom walls.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
