## II. Purpose of Addendum

On 06/19/2023, I received a modification request from Angela Barry, licensee designee for the Lansing School District, requesting that room A20 be removed as a classroom approved for use. This resulted in a decrease in capacity from 48 to 32 children aged three to six years.

## III. Methodology

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 9/12/2014 and 08/14/2023.

Forest View Kindergarten Readiness is operated by the Lansing School District and is located inside Forest View Elementary School, which is a public school for children in kindergarten through 4th grade. The following rooms were previously measured and approved and continue to be approved for child care use:

- Room A11 measures at 25ft. x 28ft., providing a total of 700 square feet. Based on 35 square feet per child, this is more than enough space for the requested capacity of 16 preschool children.
- Room A21 measures at 32ft. x 25ft., providing a total of 800 square feet. Based on 35 square feet per child, this is more than enough space for the requested capacity of 16 preschool children.
- The gymnasium is approved use space; however, the space will not be used to determine the center capacity. The gymnasium is large enough to accommodate the entire center capacity of 32 children; therefore, it was not measured.

The total center capacity is 32 children aged three to six years.

There is more than an adequate supply of developmentally appropriate materials and equipment available to support the capacity of 32 preschool children.


There is one toilet and two sinks in each of the classrooms. There is a bathroom located in the hallway next to the gymnasium which contains four toilets and four sinks. This equals a total of six toilets and eight sinks available for the children's use, which supports the center capacity of 32 children.

The center offers meals and snacks through the Lansing School District food program. Field trip transportation is provided by Lansing School District buses. Swimming is not offered.

On 10/12/2012, an "A" rated environmental health inspection was completed for the center's original issuance. On 02/28/2023, Ben Shuldiner, Lansing School District superintendent, certified that the school building complies with the 1973 school fire safety codes. A lead risk assessment was completed on 6/14/2012 for original issuance, which indicated that there are no lead hazards in the areas used by the preschool children. New inspections are not required at this time.

**V. Recommendation**

I approve the removal of room A20 as approved use space, resulting in a decrease in capacity to 32 children aged three to six years.
