II. Purpose of Addendum

On 08/19/2022, I received a modification request from Angela Barry, licensee designee for the Lansing School District, to add an additional classroom at the site and to also move the existing classroom into a new space. Room 24 would no longer be used. She also requested that the ages of children the center can care for be changed from four to six years to three to six years.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Lewton Kindergarten Readiness is located in Lewton Spanish Immersion Global Studies Magnet School, which is a public school for children in kindergarten through seventh grade operated by the Lansing School District. The center offers a Great Start Readiness Program preschool for children aged three years through six years.

There are two classrooms that are approved for use. Room 21 and 22 are both 10 ft. x 22.4 ft., plus 28.8 ft. x 27.3 ft., plus 26.5 ft. x 12.8 ft., plus 18.1 ft. x 5.3 ft., providing a total of 1,445 square feet. This is enough space for a room capacity of 41 students; however, each room's capacity toward the overall center capacity will be set at 16 apiece. There is one handwashing sink as well as a restroom that contains one handwashing sink and one toilet in each room.

The gymnasium is also approved as additional use space and was not used to determine the overall center capacity. The room is very large and can accommodate the entire center capacity; therefore, it was not measured.

This equals a total center capacity of 32. There can never be more than 32 children in care at one time.

In addition to the sinks and toilets in the classroom, there is boys' and girls' restroom located near the gymnasium that can be used by the children in care. The boys' restroom contains one handwashing sink and one toilet. The girls'


restroom contains one handwashing sink and two toilets. This equals a total of six handwashing sinks and five toilets available for the children in care. This is more than enough to support the center's capacity of 32 students.

The program offers snacks and meals through the school district lunch program. Field trip transportation is provided using the Lansing School District busses. Bussing to and from the program is provided by the school district and is not part of the licensed program. No swimming is offered.

An approved environmental health inspection was conducted on 09/01/2022 for rooms 21 and 22. An approved lead hazard risk assessment was completed on 07/07/2022 for rooms 21 and 22. The gymnasium was inspected on 05/23/2017 as part of the license's original issuance. On 08/31/2022, Ben Shuldiner, superintendent of the Lansing School District, self-certified that the building meets the 1973 school fire safety codes.

V. Recommendation

I approve the addition of classrooms 21 and 22 as use space, the removal of classroom 24, and the change in ages of children served to 3 years through 6 years.
