R 400.8149 (2) Parent permission for transportation.	The PEAK Program did not ensure that written permission was obtained and on file for field trip transportation.	The PEAK program will have the parents sign separate permission slip listing out each of the dates, times, and locations of our field trips throughout the summer.	immediate

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
