

**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8161            Emergency procedures.**

**(5) A fire drill program, consisting of at least 1 fire drill quarterly, must be established and implemented.**

There were no fire drills logged for 2021 or 2022. Ms. LaChance felt that there were drills conducted but the log was missing.

**R 400.8161            Emergency procedures.**


**(6) A tornado drill program, consisting of at least 2 tornado drills between the months of March through November, must be established and implemented.**

There were no tornado drills logged for 2021 or 2022. Ms. LaChance felt that there were drills conducted but the log was missing.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 06/01/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
