II. Purpose of Addendum

I received a modification request from Angel Bates, licensee designee, to remove the toddler classroom as child approved space and reducing the center's overall capacity from 22 children to 18 children.

III. Methodology

06/08/2023 – Modification request received.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of this license have been modified on 06/16/2023.

The facility is located in a one story free standing building located in a residential area in Hanover, Michigan. The center will now use two rooms as approved child use space, the infant room and preschool/school-age classroom. The following rooms are approved for child use space:

- The infant room measures 12 sq. ft. x 32 sq. ft. which equals 384 square feet. This allows for a capacity of 8 infants ranging in age birth to 2 ½ years old.
- The preschool/school-age room measures 12 sq. ft. x 32 sq. ft. which equals 384 square feet. This allows for a capacity of 10 children ranging in age of 3 to 12 years old.

The toddler room will no longer be used as child approved space. This classroom was approved for 4 children, which means the center's capacity has decreased from 22 children to 18 children.

The center's total capacity is now 18 children ages birth to 12 years old in care at one time. Those 18 children can be spread out in the various rooms as indicated above as long as there are never more than 18 children in care at one time and the approved capacity for each room is never exceeded. The age of the youngest child in any well defined space determines the ratio and group size requirements.

Terms:

The program will operate Monday through Friday from 6:30 am until 6:00 pm.

The center provides both full time and part time preschool and child care programming, year-round.


Transportation services will be provided by the parents and Hanover School District. The center will provide breakfast, and snacks for the children. The parents

will provide lunch. The meals are prepared in a centralized kitchen operated by the center. The meal and snack items provided by the center will consist of prepackaged and fresh food items. There is no swimming.

The center will accept children from birth to 12 years old

V. Recommendation

I recommend removing the toddler classroom as child approved space and decreasing the overall capacity from 22 children to 18 children.
