II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee designee is requesting to change the infant room to now care for children ages 2 ½ to 3 years old. The licensee designee is requesting to change the young toddler room to now include children ages birth – 2 ½ years. The licensee designee is requesting to increase the center's capacity from 50 – 52 children ages birth to 12 years of age.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 12/8/22 and 3/21/23.

The center is located inside a one-story freestanding building. The center continues to use the same pre-approved four rooms for childcare which include:

The room previously used for infants is now being used for preschool aged children. This room measures 12 ft.x18 ft. which equals 216 sq. ft. This allows for a capacity of 6 children ages 2 ½ - 3 years of age.

The main preschool room continues to consist of one large space that was divided into two separate groups of children. The separate areas measure:

- Area 1 measures 10 ft x 18 ft, plus 6 ft x 6 ft. This equals 216 sq. ft and can accommodate 6 children ages 2 ½ - 3 ½ years old.
- Area 2 measures 17 ft x 18 ft., plus 9 ft. x 7 ft. This equals 369 sq. ft. and can accommodate 10 children ages 3 ½ year – 5 years.

The room previously used for young toddlers aged 1 – 2 ½ years old is now being used for children ages birth – 2 ½ years. This room measures 21.5 ft. x 27.5 ft. which equals 591.3 sq. ft. This allows a capacity of 12 children ages birth to 2 ½ years old.

The GSRP/School age room continues care for children ages to 4 to 12 years old. This room measures 29.5 ft x 29 ft. which equals 855.5 sq. ft. This allows a requested capacity of 18 children ages 4 to 12 years old.

Total Capacity: 52 children

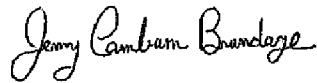
The center's total requested capacity is 52 children ages birth to 12 years in care at one time. The 52 children can be spread out in the various rooms as long as there are never more than 52 children in care at one time and the approved capacity for each room is never exceeded.

The rooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate play and learning equipment. The center has 4 toilets and 4 sinks, which support the requested capacity of 52 children.

A passing lead risk assessment was previously completed. An "A" rated fire inspection was completed on 10/26/22. An "A" rated Environmental Health Inspection was completed on 10/28/22. New inspections are not needed at this time.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the change in child use space. I recommend the increase in the center's capacity from 50 – 52 children ages birth to 12 years of age.
