The child care staff members were not accurately documenting the children's elimination patterns on the online tadpole application system when they checked or changes the children diapers each day. On 2/9/23, CCSM 1 and CCSM 2 did not provide Child A's Mother with daily accurate information regarding Child A's elimination patterns.
