I, Ms. Lisa Potvin, licensee designee was found in noncompliance of this licensing rule. I will assure the child care staff members provide the children with appropriate care and supervision at all times. On 3/27/23 Child B was allowed to traverse from one side of the room to another through a closing half door. 		<p>serious injury to his pink finger. Since the incident, we have placed safety protective padding in the doorjamb to avoid another incident from reoccurring. I have also spoken with all of the staff members to remind them of the importance of assuring the children are provided with appropriate care and supervision at all times. In addition, we also discussed the importance to assure they know what activities children are always engaged in, to include both indoor and outdoor play and positioning themselves where they can observe optimum view of the children at all times. This violation has been corrected and will be maintained at all times.</p>	
<p>R400.8170(9) Outdoor play area</p>	<p>On 3/6/23, Child B lost his footing and fell while climbing on the step platform of the climber structure with slides. This piece of play equipment was not age appropriate for Child B as the climbing structure is approved for children ages 3-12 years old.</p>	<p>I, Ms. Lisa Potvin, licensee designee was found in noncompliance of this licensing rule. I will assure the child care staff members assure the children are playing on age appropriate play equipment while engaged in outdoor play activities. I have spoken with all o the child care staff members regarding the importance of assuring the children only play on age appropriate play equipment to avoid them from being injured. I have also reminded the child care staff members of the importance of assuring they position themselves where they are able to observe optimum view of the children at all times. This violation has been corrected and will be maintained at all times.</p>	<p>07/11/2023</p>
